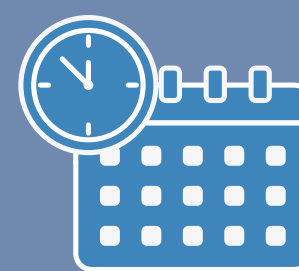
## CALL FOR PAPERS
